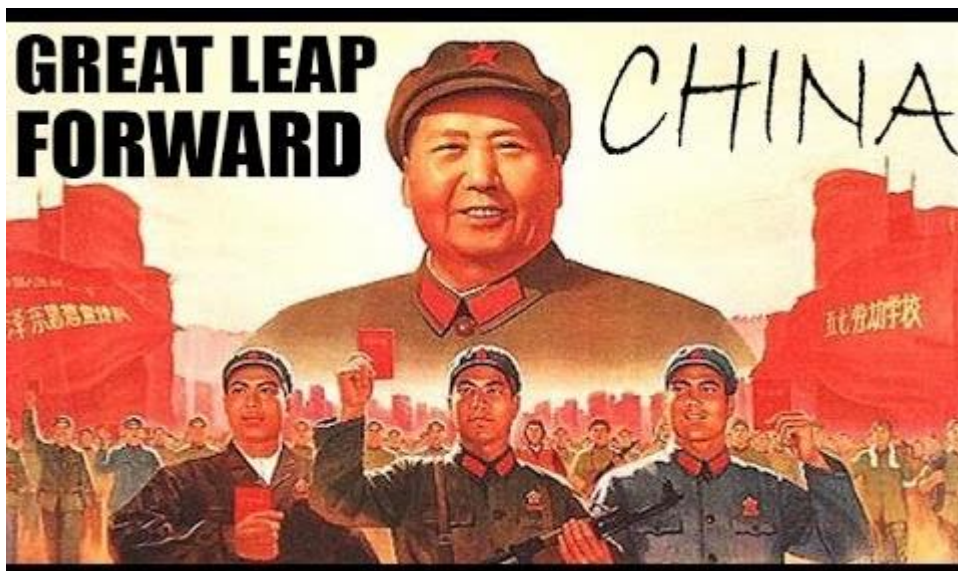

BODY

CONCLUSION

Here you re-iterate the stand that you took, and you concisely answer the question that you asked in the beginning.

REFLECTION

Write one paragraph on the process.

Write a second paragraph on what you learnt.

Write a third paragraph on how this research adds to the existing body of evidence.
